In this Season of Peace and Love, let us be mindful of our responsibility for each other, and remain vigilant of acts against Love. Consider the following security tips:

- 1. If you notice any person behaving in a suspicious manner, report it to a Warden or Hospitality Minister.
- 2. If you notice an unattended bag or observe someone about to leave a bag unattended, alert a Warden or Hospitality Minister.
- 3. Be familiar with the Church's fire exits before Mass begins. Follow the instructions of Wardens if there is an evacuation.
- 4. Do not panic and rush when you're being evacuated. Remember your safest way to safety is an orderly way.
- 5. If you see something threatening safety and security in your Church, say something to someone in charge.



The event will take place at 2.00pm on Saturday, 20 January 2018 at the Cathedral of the Good Shepherd.


His Grace, Archbishop William Goh will be the main celebrant.
