

Living the Gospel Bible Study/Sharing - FAQ

1) What is Living the Gospel (LtG) bible sharing program?

Living the Gospel is a bible study/sharing program that is conducted, via Zoom, every Wednesdays from 8.00 – 9.30pm.

2) How can this program benefit me?

It is an effective tool for helping an individual learn more about the Bible. This program gives you an opportunity to explore the teaching of Jesus and its relevance in everyday life. It hopes to help you start a personal dialogue between you and God through His word. It is also our hope that with time, it might facilitate forming of little communities among participants of this program.

3) I have a very busy work schedule and have little time to study, should I to attend every week?

It is not necessary for you to attend every weekly session. It would however be beneficial for you, as the gospel used for reflection/sharing follows the Church's liturgical calendar, hence the weekend readings. As such you would also be able to reflect on the Sunday's gospel before attending Mass on Sunday.

4) I am not familiar with the Bible at all; do I need a certain level of scripture knowledge before I sign up?

Living the Gospel is catered for everyone, especially for those of us who are unfamiliar with the bible. All you need is a desire to want to know and understand more about Jesus through the gospels. Everyone, including the facilitators, is here to share and learn from one another.

5) I am not use to sharing in a small group, is it compulsory to share?

While you are encouraged to share your thoughts and ideas about life issues, you are however not required to share if you don't feel up to it.

6) What is a typical weekly bible session like?

A typical session lasts approximately an hour and a half. Its structure is as follows;

Commence with a short prayer.

Breaking of the word for the group. – Lay presenter

Small group sharing will follow for 45 minutes to an hour.

Q & A followed by summary and closing prayers.

6) Who are the facilitators?

The facilitators are ordinary parishioners like you, who have attended past Bible study programs and are long time bible ministry members. They are dedicated disciples of Christ, willing to give their time to serve and spread the gospel message.

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8) Where and When is this program held?

The Living the Gospel bible study/sharing program is normally held via Zoom. It is scheduled for every Wednesday evenings from 8.00 – 9.30pm.
