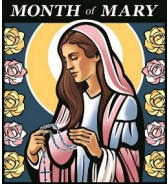

May is the month of the Rosary to honour our Blessed Mother.

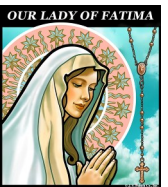


All are welcome to join us every Sunday - 24th and 31st May after the 5pm Mass at the Grotto.
